

## Instructions for Preparing Nomination Papers for Gary L. Groelle

Thank you for helping to elect Gary L. Groelle for Rock County Sheriff by participating in signature collection.

### Criteria for signing and ensuring all signatures you collect are counted:

- Signers must be eligible to vote in Wisconsin.
- Signers must be of legal voting age (18) when signing nomination form.
- Circulators are allowed to be signers. Circulators must be eligible to vote in WI and 18.
- Signing nomination papers does not obligate a person to vote for that person.
- **Signers may only sign the nomination papers of ONE candidate for Sheriff. If someone has already signed for a different gubernatorial candidate, they cannot sign for Gary L. Groelle.**

### **IMPORTANT DETAILS –**

- Sign and date the bottom of the form AFTER you've collected signatures.
- Do NOT fill in the page number on the form.

**Please read additional instructions for *Electors* and *Circulators* before having people sign.**

**Signature and Printed Name of Electors** – Only qualified electors of the state of Wisconsin may sign the nomination papers. Each elector's municipality of residence must be listed in the nomination paper along with the mailing address, including any street, fire, or rural route number, box number (if rural route) and street or road name. The Municipality of Residence listed for each signing elector must clearly identify the town, village, or city where the elector's voting residence is located. A post office box number alone does not show where the elector actually resides. Ditto marks that follow correct and complete address or date information are acceptable. The circulators may add missing or illegible address or date information before the papers are filed the filing officer. Circulators **may not** fill in the printed name of the elector.

**Signature of Circulator** – The circulator **MUST** read the language of the **Certification of Circulator** located above the signature line. *The circulator must personally present the nomination paper to each signer. The nomination paper may **not** be left unattended on counters or posted on bulletin boards.* The circulator's complete address must be listed in the certification. **After** obtaining signatures of electors, the circulator must sign and date the certification.
